

Clipper Maintenance & Repair

I do common clipper maintenance on some brands for free, and I charge for parts only. Clipper repair I charge \$15.00 plus parts.

Clipper maintenance consists of replacing some common parts on certain clippers such as: hinges, carbons, blade drives, switches, levers, etc. Clipper Repair gets more in-depth and requires more time, and pricing is described by brand name.

If you have a box of clippers that have been packed away for years, they all may need an armature from sitting, so update your clipper inventory with new ones. If something is wrong with your clipper where cost is a factor, or I have trouble fixing something the way I know it should be fixed. I don't think its right to take advantage of a repair job where its costs less to buy a new clipper than fix the old one. One Pair Per Sharpening Visit or Mail-in
