

## The #50 (Very Fine) Wahl 5-N-1 Blade

This is a very good blade, its used by more vets than groomers. Vets use it to get very close to the skin in pre-op shaving. Its not going to cut hair fast, but it will get the hair off if your patient with trying. Its not adjustable, so its only going to cut super low.

Now sometimes groomers buy them and try to use them to take off a lot of hair like the regular 5-N-1 blade, and find out it just doesn't cut at all in some coats. If you notice in the picture, there are twice as many teeth to the *very fine* blade when compared to the regular blade. The coat just doesn't feed into it sometimes. Check the picture and see the difference.



Now, if you purchased the *very fine* blade for a specific job, and your satisfied in the way it cuts for that job, then everything is OK. Refurbishing it will restore the edge again so it will cut like you want it to cut.

But, if you bought it thinking it would cut like the rest of your 5-N-1 blades, its not. If you thought it didn't cut because it was dull out of the package, or skimmed over the coat, getting it refurbished is not going to make it cut any better. Your going to have to use it in the way it was designed for, very low and not a lot of hair per swipe. Some barbers are using this blade on bald heads with great success.
